

Code of Conduct for Coaches

- 1) It is necessary for every Coach to have a current DBS check and an up to date Coaches Qualification. Coaches are asked to follow any requirements set out by England Athletics regarding their qualification.
- 2) When funded (or Part Funded) Coaches are expected to prioritise being available to South Leeds Lakers before any other club on Club Night. Coaches should also endeavour to be present on a Club Night wherever possible.
- 3) Coaches helping in a development group (C25K or 5-10K) are asked to commit to being available for the entirety of the programme wherever possible.
- 4) Coaches are expected to work alongside the Committee, Run Leaders and Runners. Any major decisions or changes should be agreed in consultation with the Committee and Run Leaders. This allows for accountability and to ensure good teamwork within the structure of the club.
- 5) It is expected that our Coaches are courteous and welcoming to all members and act in a way that would encourage 'good sportsmanship' and community.
- 6) Coaches should act in a way that upholds the integrity of the club. This includes Social Media, Club Nights or other Sporting and social events.
- 7) We expect out Coaches not to use foul or offensive language on social media, Club Nights or other sporting or social events.
- 8) Coaches should adhere to policies and procedures within the club. This includes, but is not limited to, the Social Media and Safeguarding policy.
- 9) Coaches should follow any requirements set out by England Athletics when Coaching. This includes, but is not limited to, health and safety and group sizes.
